

Dear Readers,

Organon F commences its 20th year of existence. Now, it seems incredible that, in spite of various unfavorable circumstances, it has not only survived, but also has even grown in content and form. We publish more papers in English and still more authors from around the world publish their papers in the journal. Also, and even more importantly, we are very happy that now our journal attracts more authors from Slovakia and that it publishes a lot of papers by young researchers. It is evidence that, despite the prevalence of the non-analytic philosophy at the Slovak universities, analytic philosophy has become established in the area.

Doubtless, Organon F is taken as a respected philosophical journal. The addition of the “international” to the “philosophical journal” stresses not only the fact that the journal is issued by institutions of two countries and that the papers appearing in it are written in various languages but also the fact that it is indexed in the most prestigious world databases and that the advisory board consists of, over and above the most prominent Slovak and Czech philosophers, famous philosophers from around the world. Strengthening the international scope of the journal is our primary ambition.

The Journal distribution, starting with this anniversary volume, undertakes the principal changes. Since our ambition to open up Organon F for a much wider audience and, hence, to proceed in the propagation of analytic philosophy, we come to change the edition form and the distribution policy.

Beginning with No. 1/2013, Organon F also appears in an online form and every paper is freely accessible on our website (<http://www.klemens.sav.sk/fiusav/organon>). The access to papers is unlimited and free, and there are no authorization codes. However, the print issues of the journal will still be available in selected libraries.

Allowing for these changes, which will hopefully lead to a better availability of the papers appearing in the journal, we decided to cancel the journal subscription fees for individuals and institutions. We suppose that having the papers online makes the subscription fees superfluous. However, it still holds that selected libraries and philosophical institutions will receive the printed version for free. Also, those individual readers interested in the printed version are highly invited to contact our office directly at filoorgf@savba.sk. These changes do apply to the regular as well as to the supplementary issues of the journal.

We believe that the new form of the journal distribution will be compelling not only to our readers, but also to our authors. The papers appearing in Organon F will be easily and illimitably available from all around the world. For that reason the papers, especially those written in English, can reach much more readers than before.

We believe that you will appreciate the recent changes concerning availability and distribution of our journal and that you will continually hold favor for it.
