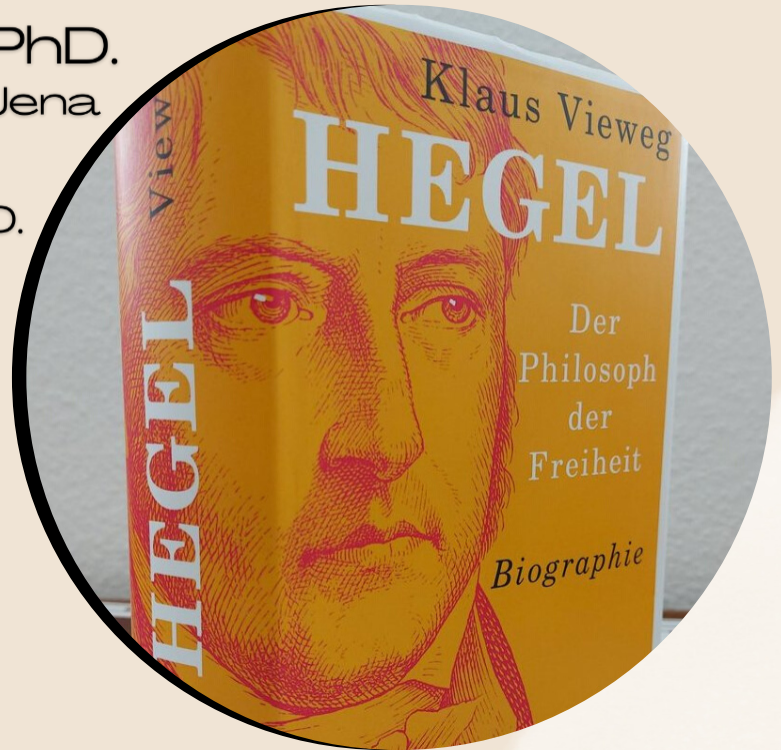

Description:

It is one cornerstone for the other history of philosophy, an entry into the philosophical writing of the history of philosophy, a history of philosophy based on philosophical logic. It is about how the history of philosophy can be cultivated as a science. The main emphasis is on the basic idea of a systematic, logical beginning of philosophizing and on where the history of philosophy can begin in an ideal-typical-paradigmatic sense.



Klaus Vieweg is a German philosopher, international Hegel known researcher, Professor for Philosophy at the Friedrich-Schiller-University Jena.

His specialty areas are German idealism and basic questions of a philosophy of freedom.

Important books: *Hegel's Philosophy of Right* (Fink 2013), *Hegels Phänomenologie des Geistes* (Suhrkamp 2008), *The Idealism of Freedom - For a Hegelian Turn in Philosophy* (Brill 2020) and the new biography *Hegel, Der Philosoph der Freiheit* (C. H. Beck 2019).
